

# VACCINATION PROTOCOL ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER VENUE

## EQUINE INFLUENZA

### Primary Course

1<sup>st</sup> Vaccination: day 0

(e.g. 1 January 2016)

2<sup>nd</sup> Vaccination: day 21-92

(e.g. 22 January 2016)

May compete 7 days after the

2<sup>nd</sup> Vaccination

**First Booster** Within 6 months of the 2<sup>nd</sup>  
vaccination of the Primary

Course

(e.g. 1 August 2016)

May compete for 6 months +21

days after the 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccination of

the Primary Course

(Must not compete in the 7 days

after receiving a vaccination)

(e.g. may enter venue after 7

August 2016)

**Boosters MINIMUM:** within one year of  
previous booster vaccination

**IF COMPETING:** must be

competing in the 6 months

+21 days from the previous

booster vaccination

Must have been vaccinated with

the 6 months +21 days before

arriving at the Event

Must not compete in the 7 days

after receiving a vaccination

Failure to re-inoculate within the specified six months' entails repeating the Primary and Secondary inoculations.

## AHS

The inoculations must be given annually and there must be an interval of at least 21 days between the first and second inoculations.

Horses may compete three weeks after the second inoculation. (three weeks)

Inoculations must be yearly with a grace period of three weeks.

Owners and horses domicile in the African Horse Sickness Free Zone should contact their Regional Body for details of the regulations applicable to that area.

It is strongly advisable that ALL vaccinations is given before 31 October of a said year.

## TETANUS

Vaccination is advisable but not compulsory.

Primary vaccination consists of 2 vaccinations 4-6 weeks apart.

Revaccination consists of 1 vaccination every year, preferably in spring, prior to the foaling season.
