ENTRY INFORMATION AND COSTS

* ENTRIES

- **Incomplete entries will not be accepted**
- Entries close on 15 March 2010. Late entries will be accepted on the following conditions:
 - a Considerations will be done according to ride management's discretion.
 - b Adequate stabling can be arranged.
 - c One and a half (1.5) x the standard entry fee will be paid.
- Please ensure that all riders and horses participating in the FEI, are registered with the FEI before you enter.
Your FEI number will be required.
(If you don't qualify for the FEI Race you can join the Erasa Race).
- This penalty clause will not be applicable if a rider, who has already registered for the ride, changes horses.

* STABLING

- There will be a Stable Map at the stables. Please ensure that you put your horse in it's designated stable/paddock. The route map and fact schedule will be on the notice board from Monday, 5 April 2010 onwards.
- Stallions must be in stables at all times. Please indicate stallions in your entries.
- Horses will **ONLY** be allowed in allocated paddocks (Not in camping area!!!)
- Horse boxes can only be parked in the designated Horse box parking **ONLY!!!**

* ACCOMMODATION

- **BOOKINGS OPEN ON 10 MARCH 2010 at 8H00**

- Booking into the event will work on a first come first serve basis
- Refunds will only be done 14 days prior to the ride with deduction of 50% admin fee.
- Without proof of your own fixed residential address, you will not be accepted into local accommodation
- You can only reserve your entry into the championship for 24 hours. Your reservation will then be available for the next entrant.
- You need to pay your full accommodation bill to ensure that you will indeed have a definite booking.

Camping

- * R 300.00 per stand. (7mx7m stand)

Hostel

* RIDE DETAILS

Please note: The ride is a CEI ** 120km & ERASA 120km. Therefore ALL FEI rules and regulations will apply to all riders, whether they have entered the ERASA or CEI ride. The only exception to this - where FEI rules will apply to CEI horses and riders and ERASA rules will apply to ERASA riders are:

- * Pre qualification of horses

* WEIGHT CATEGORIES

- FEI & ERASA - rider and saddle only
 - * CEI ** 120km = 73kg- Light, 73kg+ Standard, 95kg+ Heavy weight
 - * CEI ** 120km = Junior & Young rider - no minimum weight

* PULSE

- As per FEI rules (64bpm)

* **DISTANCE**

- The FEI registered distances will be:
- * CEI** 120km Senior
- * CEI** 120km Junior & Young rider (age from the year in which the rider turns 14 until rider turns 21)
- Senior age category is from the year in which the rider turns 18 years of age. Only FEI registered riders and horses may participate in the FEI distance

* **DEPARTURE TIMES**

- Final departure times will be announced at the Pre Ride briefing on 7 April 2010 at 19H00.

* **GROOMING**

- Grooming will ONLY be allowed at grooming area
- There will be distance indicators every 5km and water points every 5km's
 - * **ONLY OFFICIALS AND EMERGENCY VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE COURSE**

* **COURSE AND LAP DETAILS**

- For full details regarding the course please study the Maps and Fact sheet on the website
- **Please note** - this course has gentle ups and downs and lots of turns. We recommend shoeing your horse or using hoof boots as protection. The first leg runs mostly on gravel road.
- This is a barefoot friendly course

* **RESTING TIMES**

- Horses are allowed a 20 minute grooming time between first gate and the vet point and 25 minutes to the start of the next leg. (i.e. 45 minutes)
- After completion of the 3rd leg horses are allowed 20 minutes grooming time to the vet point plus 35 minutes to the start of the 4th lap. (Compulsary Recovery Inspection) (i.e. 55 minutes)

* **TIME STOP**

- A Time stop will occur at the Vet point, except on the rider's last lap the time will be stopped when the rider crosses the finish line.
- Riders must depart and finish mounted.

* **PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES**

- Testing for prohibited substances **WILL** be done. Riders should ensure that they conform to the Anti-Doping regulations as per FEI / ERASA rules and regulations.

* **CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT**

- As per FEI rules and regulations
 - * Protected headgear: Of a recognized equestrian / endurance standard
 - * Safe footwear: With heels of 12mm or more or caged / boxed safety stirrups
 - * Dress code will apply to riders and grooms at Pre-check & Best conditioned Horse evaluation.
 - * All riders must participate in their international, provincial or club colours.
