1. Horses must be presented with a FEI passport or FEI approved NF passport and recognition card. All vaccinations must be up to date.
2. At the First Inspection please ensure that your horse is sufficiently warmed up. Any horse that fails to present, or which is dangerous to the examiners will be eliminated.
3. Pre-Ride briefing in the vet gate area at the end of the First Inspection.
4. Riders must wear a hard riding helmet with chin strap and shoes with 12mm heel unless they use caged or equestrian safety stirrups.
5. Whips, spurs, draw reins, French reins or long reins are not permitted. Any tack restricting the free movement of a horse's head is prohibited.
6. No more than two persons and the rider shall be permitted with the horse inside the vet gate. Any act of deliberate delay in presenting the horse for examination will lead to a yellow card or will be under penalty of disqualification.
7. Recovery inspections, compulsory or requested, will be up to 15 minutes before departure.
8. There will be a Best Conditioned horse Competition of the first 5 horses within one hour after the arrival of the winner.
9. Grooming will be allowed at all water points and designated areas.
