#### ENTRY RULES:

- **Entries close 12 August 2019.**
- All entries fees must be paid by 12 August 2019. **NO entries will be approved without proof of payment.**
- All payments must be done **via EFT** to the account: **Duneside Equestrian Club, Bank Windhoek, Gobabis 481-172, Acc. nr 8012683957.** ( **no cash payments would be accepted**)
- Proof of payment must be forwarded to [cgs@iway.na](mailto:cgs@iway.na)
- Refunds would be available for cancelations upon presentation of a veterinary certificate.
- Paying of entry fees will indicate that participants would agree to adhere to the accompanied stable and safety rules
- **Entry fees: N\$ 400 per entry**
- **Stabling fees: N\$80 per outside stable, N\$120 for inside stables, own paddocks free of charge.**
- **Stables need to be booked with Riaan 081 226 6122 and paid to above account of Duneside.**
- **Ground levy: N\$75 per rider**

### Stable Rules

- Drive on designated roads only, and park in the parking areas. SPEED LIMIT is 40 km/ph.
- Please keep tack areas clean. Use trash containers, pick up poop, and put in specified barrels or bins.
- The stable manager reserves the right to close any arena, round pen or pasture at any time.
- All DEC members and visitors must adhere to the FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse.
- Stables need to be booked with Riaan. 081 226 6122

### Safety Rules

- Infractions of these rules may result in management requesting removal of owners and their horses from this facility.
- Horses are personal property. Only owners and stable management have the right to deal with a horse, as they deem appropriate. DO NOT FEED any horse unless you have the owner's permission. If you notice signs of colic, injury, a horse that is cast, or other catastrophe, please alert stable management immediately. However, do not take matters in to your own hands.
- Each person that enters the grounds do so at own risk and will not hold the OC, DEC or Sandune Lodge responsible for any injury, property theft or damage or any other matter.
- Management strongly recommends that ALL riders wear a riding helmet.
- Children may only ride on the premises if they have a BOTH a riding agreement and a consent form filled out by parents or guardians.
- NO SMOKING!!!
- Keep all gates closed and latched
- NO dogs allowed.
- The stable is for equestrian activities only. No running, biking, loud noises or any other activities that may cause horses to spook, shy, run off, or become aggressive.
- Please keep your horse at a walk when not in arenas and are within the immediate boarding stable or drive way.
