GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. The following documents must be brought to the ride:
Rider logbook (completed)
Horse logbook/CEI passport (completed)
Proof of Club membership, if other than Okanjande Club.
(Logbooks and vaccinations must be completed correctly to CEI prescriptions)
2. All distances other will be ridden under CEI* rules as a "vet gate" ride. (32 km and 64km)
3. The 80km distance will be a registered CEI* ride and will be ridden under such rules.
Shorter distances will be ridden under NERA rules as a 'vet gate' ride.
4. Minimum age and pre-rides for a horse to participate is as per clause
5. SEE FEI NEW RULE SENDE OUT TO ALL

Mares obviously in advanced pregnancies, meaning over 120 days, or with foal at foot cannot be entered in any CEI or NERA event.

See new Novice rule.

It is the rider's own responsibility to ensure that his/her horse qualifies for the distance that such a rider wants to participate in.

6. Maximum Pulse at Vet Gates: 64bpm within 20 minutes. At final Exams, the maximum pulse shall be 64 within 30 minutes.

Holding times as per FEI regulations

7. Maximum time to Vet is 20 minutes on all legs except the last leg which has a 30 minute time to vet.
8. Time stop for all distances at the vet point except for the rider's last leg when the rider's time will be stopped when such rider crosses the Finish Line.
9. **SADDLERY AND EQUIPMENT**

In principle, there is no restriction on saddlery; however Draw (Running) Reins/French Reins are forbidden no tack restricting the free movement of the horses head, but saddlery must be in safe condition and should fit the horse.

Specific safety equipment, such as reflective items or otherwise, may be required as indicated in the schedule of the competition.

The use of mobile phones and GPS devices are permitted. All other forms of communication devices must be approved by the Ground Jury prior to competition.
