GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The following documents must be brought to the ride:
Ride logbook (**completed**)
Horse logbook/FEI passport (**completed**)
(Logbooks and vaccinations must be completed correctly according to FEI prescriptions)
2. The ride will be a qualifying FEI ride and be ridden under such rules.
79,8 km*, 99,8 km *, 120,7 km ** and 161 km *** distances will be registered FEI rides.
3. Minimum age and pre-rides for a horse to participate are as per Article 816 of the FEI rules:
Under the age of 5 years – not allowed to participate
5 years – the maximum distance is **80 km – 90 km**
6 years – for CEI* and CEI**
7 years – for CEI***
Mares obviously in advanced pregnancies or with foal at foot cannot be entered for any event.
Riders and horses wishing to participate in the CEI-qualifying rides should have successfully completed 2 rides of between 40 and 79 km and 2 rides of between 80 and 90 km at speeds of 16km/h or under, or, alternatively, successfully completed 3 rides of between 80 and 90 km at speeds of 16km/h or under.

It is the rider's own responsibility to ensure that his/her horse qualifies for the distance in which such a rider wants to participate.

4. Maximum pulse at Vet Gates: 64 bpm within 20 minutes. At final exams, the maximum pulse shall be 64 bpm within 30 minutes.

5. Ride distances:

PLEASE TAKE NOTE THAT DISTANCES OF SOME OF THE LEGS MAY CHANGE DUE TO THE FLOW OF THE RIVER.

6. Maximum time to vet is 20 minutes on all legs except the last leg which has a 30-minute time to vet. Holding times between legs are **45 minutes** for all legs except for the 161-km leg, where the holding time between legs is 50 minutes.
7. A vet re-inspection for participants will be announced at the ride.
8. Time stops for all the distances at the vet point except for the rider's last leg when the rider's time will be stopped when such a rider crosses the **finishing line**.
9. **Weight divisions for senior riders are as follows:**
No-weight division, standard-weight 70 kg (75 kg for 161km) + and heavy-weight division 95 kg +
10. Categories of riders
Child Riders: 13 years and under – children are allowed to ride on their own from the age of 12 years
Young Riders: The year in which a rider turns 14 – 21 years
No-weight: The year in which a rider turns 14 and chooses not to compete in the **Young Rider division and all senior riders who choose not to weigh.**
Senior Riders: A rider who turns 14 during the year and weighs between 70 kg (75 kg for 161 km) and 95 kg may compete in this category.
Heavy-weight: 95 kg +

11. The minimum time limit is 10km/h.
12. In order to be valid all **complaints** must be in writing and accompanied by a prescribed deposit.
13. Nobody except the official vets may under any circumstances give **injections** to any of the horses participating in the ride. Failure to adhere to this rule will lead to immediate disqualification of the horse and the rider. **In the case where a horse is referred to the treatment veterinarian, the costs incidental to the treatment have to be paid by the owner and/or rider.**
14. No horses may **leave** the premises after the event unless signed out by the appointed veterinarian.
15. Horses may be ridden without shoes, but if shod they must be correctly shod and the shoes must be in a suitable condition for the competition. No whips will be allowed. **A third party encouraging a horse to trot in the vet gate is forbidden. Riders must please ensure that horses are trained to trot without encouragement.**
16. Please take note that ALL riders and horses participating in this event must comply with all FEI rules and regulations.
