Food and drinks will be available at the kiosk at the stable from early till late every day.

RIDE INFORMATION

1. The following documents must be brought to the ride:
Rider logbook (completed)
Horse logbook/FEI passport (completed)
(Logbooks and vaccinations must be completed according to FEI prescriptions)
2. The ride will be a qualifying FEI ride and will be ridden under such rules.
80*km, 120**km and 160***km distances will be registered FEI rides.
3. Minimum age and pre-rides for a horse to participate as per Article 816 of the FEI rules:
Under the age of 5 years – not allowed to participate
5 years for the maximum distance of 80km – 90km
6 years for CEI* and CEI**
7 years for CEI***
Mares obviously in advanced pregnancies or with foal at foot cannot be entered for any event.
Riders and horses wishing to participate in the CEI qualifying rides should have successfully completed two rides of distances between 40 and 79 km and two rides of between 80 and 90 km at speeds of 16km/h or under in no less than 12 months.
It is the rider's own responsibility to ensure that his/her horse qualifies for the distance in which such a rider wants to participate.
4. Maximum pulse rate at vet gates: 64 bpm within 20 minutes. At final examination the maximum pulse rate shall be 64 bpm within 30 minutes.
5. A vet re-inspection for participants will be announced at the ride.
6. Time stops apply to all the distance at the vet point except for the rider's last leg when the rider's time will be stopped when such a rider crosses the finishing line.
7. Weight divisions for senior riders are as follows:
8. No weight division, Standard weight 70kg (75kg for 160***km) and heavy weight 9kg+
9. Categories for riders:
Child riders: 13 years and under – children are allowed to ride on their own from the year they turn 12
Young riders: the year in which he/she turns 14 up to 21 years.
No weight: the year in which a rider turns 14 and chooses not to compete in the young rider division; and all senior riders who choose to participate in this category.
Senior riders: the year in which a rider turns 14 and weighs between 70kg (75kg for 160km) and 95kg may compete in this category.
Heavy weight: 95kg+
10. The minimum speed limit is 10km/h and 7.5km/h for 30km
11. To be valid all complaints must be in writing and accompanied by a prescribed deposit.
12. Nobody except the official vet may under any circumstances give injections to any of the horses participating in the ride. Failure to adhere to this rule will lead to immediate disqualification of the horse and its rider. In case where a horse is referred to the treatment veterinarian, the costs incidental to the treatment has to be paid by the owner and/or the rider.
13. No horses may leave the premises after the event unless signed out by the appointed veterinarian.
14. Horses may be ridden without shoes, but if shod they must be correctly shod and the shoes must be in a suitable condition for the competition. No whips will be allowed. A third party encouraging a horse to trot in the vet gate is forbidden. Riders must please ensure that horses are trained to trot without encouragement.
15. Please take note that ALL riders and horse participating in this event must comply with ALL FEI rules and regulations.
