GENERAL INFORMATION:

- The following documents must be brought to the ride:
 Ride logbook (completed)
 Horse logbook (completed)
 (Logbooks and vaccinations must be completed correctly to FEI prescriptions)
 30km Riders do not need to have a logbook, nor a Horse logbook.
- 2. The ride will be a Nera Club Ride as well qualifying FEI Novice ride and be ridden under such rules.
- Minimum age and pre-rides for a horse to participate is as per clause 815 of the FEI rules.
 Under the age of 5 years not allowed to participate
 6 years, maximum distance of 80 km
 6 years and older 100 km

Mares obviously in advanced pregnancies, meaning over 120 days, or with foal at foot cannot be entered.

Qualification for Novice Horse and Riders are as follows:

816.1.1 Horses and Athletes must, though not necessarily as a combination:

816.1.1.1 Successfully complete 2 rides of distances between 40-79 km and 2 rides of between 80-90 km not exceeding 16 km/h on average.

816.1.2 Athletes and Horses must complete the requirements of this qualifying phase all within the 24 month period and no shorter than 12 months, immediately prior to taking part in an FEI competition. *

*Riders should be aware that the revised novice rules for 2014 have been adapted as follows:

- 1). The new FEI Rules prohibits open speed rides during the novice period.
- 2). All novice horses have to complete 2 rides between 40-79km and 2 rides of between 80-90km at an average speed NOT EXCEEDING 16km/h on average.
- 3). Only after completing all novice rides and after 12 MONTHS of the first novice ride, may horse or rider participate in a 1* event.
- 4). Horses that have completed their novice qualification (i.e that have successfully finished $2 \times 40-79 \, \mathrm{km}$ distances and $2 \times 80-90 \, \mathrm{km}$ distances) and have been participating in endurance competitions for MORE than 12 months since starting their endurance career , MAY participate in longer NERA distances rides at open speed.

A few new FEI Rules for 2014;

815.2 Horses:

815.2.1 Horses must be at least 5 years old to qualify as Novices.

815.2.2 For CEIs 1-Star through 2-Star competitions horses must be at least 6 years old to participate.

815.2.3 For 3-Stars competitions horses must be at least 7 years old to participate.

815.2.4 For 4-Stars, CEIOs and Championships (excluding Young Horse Championships where the minimum age must be 7 years) horses must be at least 8 years of age.

It is the riders own responsibility to ensure that his/her horse qualifies for the distance that such a rider wants to participate in.

- 4. Maximum pulse at Vet Gates: 64bpm within 20 minutes. At final exams, the pulse shall be 64 within 30 minutes.
- 5. Maximum time to vet is 20 min on all faces except the last face which has a 30 minute time to vet.
- 6. Time stops for all the distances at the vet point except for the rider's last face when the rider's time will be stopped when such rider crosses the finish line.
- 7. Weight divisions for Senior riders are as follows:
 NERA rides No weight, standard weight 70kg, heavy weight 95kg
 CEI* rides No weight, standard weight 70kg, heavy weight 95kg
- 8. Categories for riders:

Child riders: Under the year in which he / she turns 14 – children are allowed to ride on their own from the year in which he / she turns 12 years of age.

Junior Young Rider: The year in which he/she turns 14 years – 21 years

- 9. All complaints to be valid, must be in writing and be submitted to the Chairman.
- 10. Nobody except the official vets may under any circumstances give injections to any horse participating in the ride. Failure to observe this rule will lead to immediate disqualification of the horse and rider. In cases where horses need special veterinary care, this has to be paid by the owner/rider.
- 11. Horses may be ridden without shoes, but we recommend that horses be shod who has not being prepared for barefoot riding. This is a barefoot friendly course.
- 12. Hard hats are compulsory whenever you are on your horse, before, during and after the Ride. Caged/boxed stirrups or safe footwear with a heel of 12mm are compulsory. No whips will be allowed.
- 13. A third party encouraging a horse to trot in the vet gate is forbidden. Riders must please ensure that horses are trained to trot without encouragement.
- 14. Dress code: Nera has adopted a casual, but appropriate dress code for the Nera Club Rides. Riders should wear appropriate riding attire during competition, but shirt/polo shirt does not have to include a collar.
 - Shorts are allowed at the entire ride base at Nera Rides.
- 15. The Official Competition starts 1 hour before pre-vetting and 1 hour after the final results are out.
- 16. Time stop will occur for all distances at the vet point, except on the rider's last loop when the rider's time will be stopped when they cross the finish line. Riders have to depart mounted on their first loop and have to be mounted on their last loop when crossing the finishing line.
 - Riders should ensure that they conform to the anti-doping regulations as per FEI rules and regulations.
- 17. Running reins/ drawing reins, German martingales or any other restrictive headgear on a a horse is explicitly forbidden as per FEI rule.
- 18. There are limited stables and kraals available, so riders are encourage to bring their own paddocks along.
