### **TROPHIES, AWARDS AND ACKNOWLEDGMENTS**

The Namibia Endurance Ride Association presents the following awards :

#### **A. Namibian NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

##### **AWARD QUALIFICATION**

Family Choice Senior Heavy Weight Champion.	Awarded to the senior heavy weight rider to complete the 160km in the shortest time.
Family Choice Senior Standard Weight Champion.	Awarded to the senior standard weight rider to complete the 160 km in the shortest time.
NERA -Best conditioned horse senior	Awarded to the horse, ridden by a senior rider, to complete the ride in best condition.
NERA - Junior champion	Awarded to the Junior & Young rider to complete the 120km in the shortest time.
NERA - Best conditioned horse junior	Awarded to the horse, ridden by a Junior & Young rider, to complete the ride in the best condition.
Family Choice Child Rider Champion	Awarded to the Child rider to complete the 120 km in the shortest time.
Gullilah Horsemanship Award snr.	Awarded to the senior rider with the best results in appearance of the rider and the horse, the best horsemanship and the best style and movement of his/her horse.
Gullilah Horsemanship Award jnr.	Awarded to the Junior & Young Rider rider with the best results in appearance of the rider and the horse, the best horsemanship and the best style and movement of his/her horse.

Cowboy Saddle Shop Novice horse	Awarded to the novice horse to complete the 160km in the shortest time.
Sentra Superama "Skilpad" Trophy	Awarded to the rider with the slowest km/h speed at the Championships irrespective of the distance.
<p><u>Shoprite Yellow Championship Bips</u>          These bips are worn from a period of one year beginning after this Years National C/ships until the following years C/ Ships at all NERA and club rides in Namibia.</p>	
No 1. Standard Weight Champion	Awarded to the Standard Weight 160 km Winner of the National C/Ships, If such a rider is also the overall winner as well. If not such a rider will wear the No 2 Standard Weight Bip(where a Senior Heavy Weight was the overall winner).
No 2. Standard Weight Champion	Awarded to the Standard Weight 160 km Winner if such a rider finishes second overall after the Heavy Weight Winner.
No. 1 Heavy Weight Champion	Awarded to the Heavy Weight 160 km Winner of the National C/Ships if such a rider is also the overall winner. If not such a rider will wear the No 2 Heavy Weight Bip.
No 2. Heavy Weight Champion	Awarded to the Heavy Weight 160 km Winner If such a rider finishes second overall after the Standard Weight Winner.
No 3. Junior & Young rider Champion	Awarded to the Junior & Young rider 120 km winner.
No A Child Champion	Awarded to the Child 120 km Winner.
<b>FNB Team Floating Trophy</b>	Awarded to the NERA Club winner.

**Karoo Osche Floating Trophy.**

Awarded to the 130 km winner,  
Senior and Junior & Young Rider.

Overall winner trophy

Awarded to the senior rider to  
complete the 160km in the shortest  
time

Standard weight floating trophy

Awarded to the rider in the standard  
weight category to complete the 160  
km ride in the shortest time.

Heavy weight floating trophy

Awarded to the Senior Heavy Weight  
rider to complete the 160 km  
ride in the shortest time.

Frè Bergh floating trophy

Awarded to the Junior & Young rider  
rider to complete the 1210 km ride in  
the shortest rime.

Eastern Glass floating trophy

Awarded to the horse, ridden by a  
senior rider, to complete the ride in  
the best condition.

Elmaros Stud trophy

Awarded to the horse, ridden by a  
Junior & Young Rider to complete  
the 120 km ride in the best  
condition.

Luc du Boisson floating trophy

Awarded to the 160 km senior rider  
with the best horsemanship and the  
best style and movement of his/her  
horse.

Graham Anderson floating trophy

Awarded to the 120 km Junior &  
Young rider with the best results in  
appearance of rider and horse, the  
best horsemanship and the best  
style and movement of his/her  
horse.

Coetzer floating trophy	Awarded to the National Senior 160 km team to complete the ride in the shortest time.
Old Mutual floating trophy	Awarded to the National Junior & Young rider 120 km team to complete the ride in the shortest time.
NERA floating trophy	Awarded to the open Senior 160 km Team to complete the ride in the Shortest time.
Graham Anderson Tortoise Trophy	Awarded to the rider with the slowest speed at the ride calculated in km / h for any distance.
Buckle	A bronze buckle may be awarded to every 160 km Senior rider and every 120 km Junior & Young rider and 120 km Child Rider who successfully complete the ride.

### **OTHER AWARDS**

Certificate	<p>A completion certificate must be awarded to every rider to complete the ride successfully for all distances as from a 30 km.</p> <p>The first three places for all distances are specified on the certificate and from the forth place downwards only the distance and time are specified with the exception that at the Walvis Bay ride the first ten placing for the 120 and 160 km riders are specified.</p>
Kilometer Acknowledgment	Every 1000 km completed by a horse and/or rider are acknowledged. The rider receives a scroll inscribed with he number of 1000km attained. The

owner of the horse receives a cloth inscribed with the number of 1000 km which have been completed by the horse.

Awards are not limited to the above awards and the Organising Committee of any ride may authorise any other trophies and/ or awards that such an OC may see fit.
