NAMIBIAN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS – DRESSAGE

The Annexure E 2019 overrules the current Championship rules of NAMEF Rules & Regulations Version, where applicable.

The Namibian Championships for Dressage will be offered from

- Elementary level upwards for Children and Junior/Adults.

There will be two National Championships:

- a) The Namibian National Dressage Champion – age 16 Years and up;
 - b) Namibian National Youth Dressage Champion – 15 Years and below.
- The highest overall percentage of the three tests combined (inclusive of a Musical Freestyle) will be awarded the Namibian National Dressage Champion with runner up as the Reserve Champion.
 - In the probability of a tie, the higher Collective Marks will determine the Champion.
 - A further Tie will mean that the Championship be awarded to both athletes.
 - Individual classes may be separated between Junior and Adults, but the overall Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded according to % achieved.

NAMIBIAN NATIONAL CLUB TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS - DRESSAGE

- Namibian National Club Team Championship is open to all NAMEF affiliated clubs.
- The team shall consist of 4 riders of which one rider may be a "guest rider" (a rider belonging to another NAMEF club).
- The best 3 results will count towards the Namibian National Club Team Championships.
- No competitor may participate more than once in the Namibian National Club Team Championships.
- The club must nominate their team, one hour after the vet check in writing together with the entry fee in cash.
- No changes are allowed after nomination and payment has been submitted.
- Entry fee is not refundable.
- A club may enter more than one team.
- Athletes riding more than one horse, must make sure that the team horse is starting first.
- The final percentages (all three tests) of the best (nominated) competitors will be added together and will give the overall percentage.
- The highest overall % achieved will be the Namibian National Club Team Champion with runner up the Reserve Champion.
- In the probability of a Tie the highest Collective marks of the three best competitors will determine the winner.
- The awarding of Prize money is up to the discretion of the OC.
- Should there be two teams only 1st place will be awarded as Namibian National Team Champion.
- Should there be more than two teams a Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded.

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS – JUMPING

The Namibian National Championships for Jumping will be offered as follows: -

- The Namibian National Jumping Champion
- Namibian National Youth Jumping Champion – 15 Years and below.

a) NAMIBIAN NATIONAL JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS DETERMINED at THE HEIGHT OF 1.20cm

b) NAMIBIAN NATIONAL YOUTH JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS from THE HEIGHT OF .90cm

- The Namibian National Show Jumping Championships (1.20M) is open to ALL including - Children/Youth (15 years and below)
- Children/Youth riders may compete in both Championships with two different horses.
- The Championships will be judged under the NAMEF rule 2.7.1
- Only levels from the height of 0,90cm (15 and younger) will be allowed for Youth Championships.
- Children/Juniors/Adults compete from height of 1.20m to qualify as Namibian National Champion.

NAMIBIAN NATIONAL CLUB TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS – JUMPING

Under NAMEF rule 2.7.2

- The height of the CLUB Championships will be determined by the OC and President of Ground Jury prior to the start of the Championships
- The three best scores (with one drop score) will count towards the Namibian National Team Championships.
- In case of an equality of score, the team with the fastest time will be the winner.
- Clubs must nominate their teams one hour after the vet check in writing together with the entry fee.
- No changes will be accepted after the payment has been received
- The entry fee is non- refundable
- A club may enter more than one team
- One guest rider (a member from another NAMEF club) may be entered to form a team
- No competitor may participate in more than one team
- Prize money is at the discretion of the OC
- Should there be two teams only 1st place will be awarded as Namibian National Team Champion.
- Should there be more than two teams a Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded.
- Club Numnahs and Club shirts are allowed during the team competition.

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS – EVENTING

The Namibian National Eventing Championships will be offered for Children and Junior/Adults.

- The Namibian National Eventing Champion – 16 Years and up;
 - Namibian National Youth Eventing Champion – 15 Years and below.
- a) The height for the Namibian National Youth Eventing Championships will be EV 80.
b) The height for the Namibian National Eventing Championships will be EV 100.

NAMIBIAN NATIONAL EVENTING CLUB TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS

- The Namibian National Eventing Club Team Championship shall consist of a maximum of 4 competitors with one drop score (three scores to count).
- A club may enter more than one team
- Team riders may consist of competitors riding at different graded levels
- No Multiplier for higher classes will be applied
- A club must nominate their team one hour after the vet check in writing together with the entry fee payment
- No changes are allowed after payment has been received.
- No entry fee will be refunded
- ONE guest rider (member of another club) may form part of the team
- No competitor may ride in more than one team
- Prize money is for the discretion of the OC
- Athletes can ride with Club numnahs and Club shirts.
