

Website entries:

- The Horse and Rider fields on the entry site are looking for registration numbers. If you do not remember them, you can type two or more letters of the name of the Rider / Horse and it will suggest you an entry which you can click on to fill out the field ...

The two fields also accept the full name of the horse / rider (without spelling mistakes ☺) or FEI registration numbers ...

Please also note that I had not have a chance yet to implement the 2017 changes to the qualification checks. Over the past years, the changes gotten more and more complex and are more susceptible to errors due to overlapping rule sets from the past ...
