

## FEI WORLD ENDURANCE RANKINGS

### General Principles

- Points are awarded based on the results in International Competitions under FEI Rules and on the star rating of the Individual Event.
- A rider must complete the event in order to receive points. Rider earns points based upon his/her final rank in each FEI Competition.
- Points are awarded upon receipt of the Official Results.
- The FEI Endurance Rankings List is produced by the FEI Secretariat.

### Calculation of the World Ranking List

- Rankings are compiled from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December each year.
- Rankings are updated and published every month, preferably during the first week of the month. They can be consulted on the official FEI Website [www.horsesport.org](http://www.horsesport.org) inside the Results section of Endurance.
- The FEI World Ranking List is a ranking of Riders. The Ranking List takes into consideration the Senior FEI Competition of each Rider with any of his/her horses.
- At the end of each year, a horse and a combination ranking lists will be published.

### Point System

- Points are awarded as follows :

- Once the position is reach where a Rider is awarded 5, 4, 3, 2 or 1 point (according to the event category), all finishers thereafter receive the same points, i.e. 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1.
